SUBJECT: Request for Bed Height Adjustment

Hi Bulldog,

We are getting closer to opening for fall 2025 and we know you may be logging on to The Dawg House to sign-up for an arrival time soon. We wanted to share this information about bed height as the form to adjust your bed height will also be available starting on Monday, July 7.

Upon move in, beds will be at their highest point (default height). If you would like your bed lowered to a different height *before your arrival*, complete the **BED HEIGHT CHANGE REQUEST** by July 21 under **FORMS** in <u>The Dawg House</u>. Should you choose to make this request in <u>The Dawg House</u>, you do not need to submit a work request through the housing website.

There are <u>three heights</u> from which to choose:

- Default height: minimum of 52" of clearance under the bed with a mattress height of approximately 62" (some bed frames allow up to 57.75" of clearance with a mattress height of 67")
- Mid-height: clearance under the bed frame is approximately 33" with a mattress height approximately 40" from the floor; this allows for the standard dressers to be placed under the beds
- Traditional height: clearance of 15.75" under the bed with a mattress height approximately 26" from the floor

A small number of rooms may not accommodate certain bed heights due to ceiling height and furniture layout, as all furniture must remain in student rooms.

If you prefer to make this decision after arriving on campus, you may adjust the bed height yourself or submit a request to have staff assist with the bed height adjustment via a **work request**. These work requests will be scheduled for on or after the first day of class.

SUBJECT: Request for Bed Height Adjustment

Hi Bulldog,

We are getting closer to opening for fall 2025 and looking forward to your arrival. We wanted to share information about bed height.

Beds will be at the default height upon your arrival. You may adjust the bed height yourself after arrival or request a staff-assisted bed height adjustment via <u>work request</u>. These work requests will be scheduled for on or after the first day of class.

Please keep in mind you are assigned to a building where some furniture may be set up to fit under the lofted bed. Should you choose to lower the bed to a height where the furniture no longer fits underneath, that furniture cannot be removed from the room.

Default height: Minimum of 52" of clearance under the bed with a mattress height of approximately 62" (some bed frames allow up to 57.75" of clearance with a mattress height of 67".
