Section: Residence Halls

Policy: Residents may have fish in properly maintained aquariums of 20 gallons or less.

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to define the pet policy for all University Housing residents.

Scope: This policy applies to staff (except full-time, live-in staff), residents, visitors and guests of University Housing. For information regarding ESAs (Emotional Support Animals) see that specific policy.

Procedure:

- I. Fish in aquariums of 20 gallons or less are the only pets approved in residence halls.
- II. Aquariums must be properly maintained and meet Underwriters Laboratories (UL) standards.
- III. Each resident is permitted no more than one aquarium.
