

SOLICITATION AND FUNDRAISING

Section: Residence Halls – All Halls

Policy: Solicitation is prohibited on University Housing property. Fundraising in residence halls and apartment buildings is limited to housing-sponsored fundraising organizations.

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to prohibit solicitation in the residence halls and apartment buildings and limit who is permitted to fundraise on University Housing property.

Scope: This policy applies to all staff, students and visitors to the residence halls and apartment buildings, as well as guests of University Housing.

Procedure:

- I. University Housing groups may fundraise inside buildings managed by University Housing. Fundraising may only take place outdoors and in public areas of housing facilities. Fundraising activities outside of the halls must comply with guidelines set forth by the Engagement, Leadership, and Service department (<https://studentaffairs.uga.edu/dos/business-office/fundraising/>).
- II. Non-housing groups may not fundraise inside buildings managed by University Housing. Non-housing groups may fundraise outside of residence halls. Fundraising activities outside the halls must comply with guidelines set forth by the Engagement, Leadership, and Service department (<https://studentaffairs.uga.edu/dos/business-office/fundraising/>).
- III. Registered student groups should provide an approved fundraising request form when requesting to use University Housing space for a fundraising event (<https://studentaffairs.uga.edu/dos/business-office/fundraising/>).
