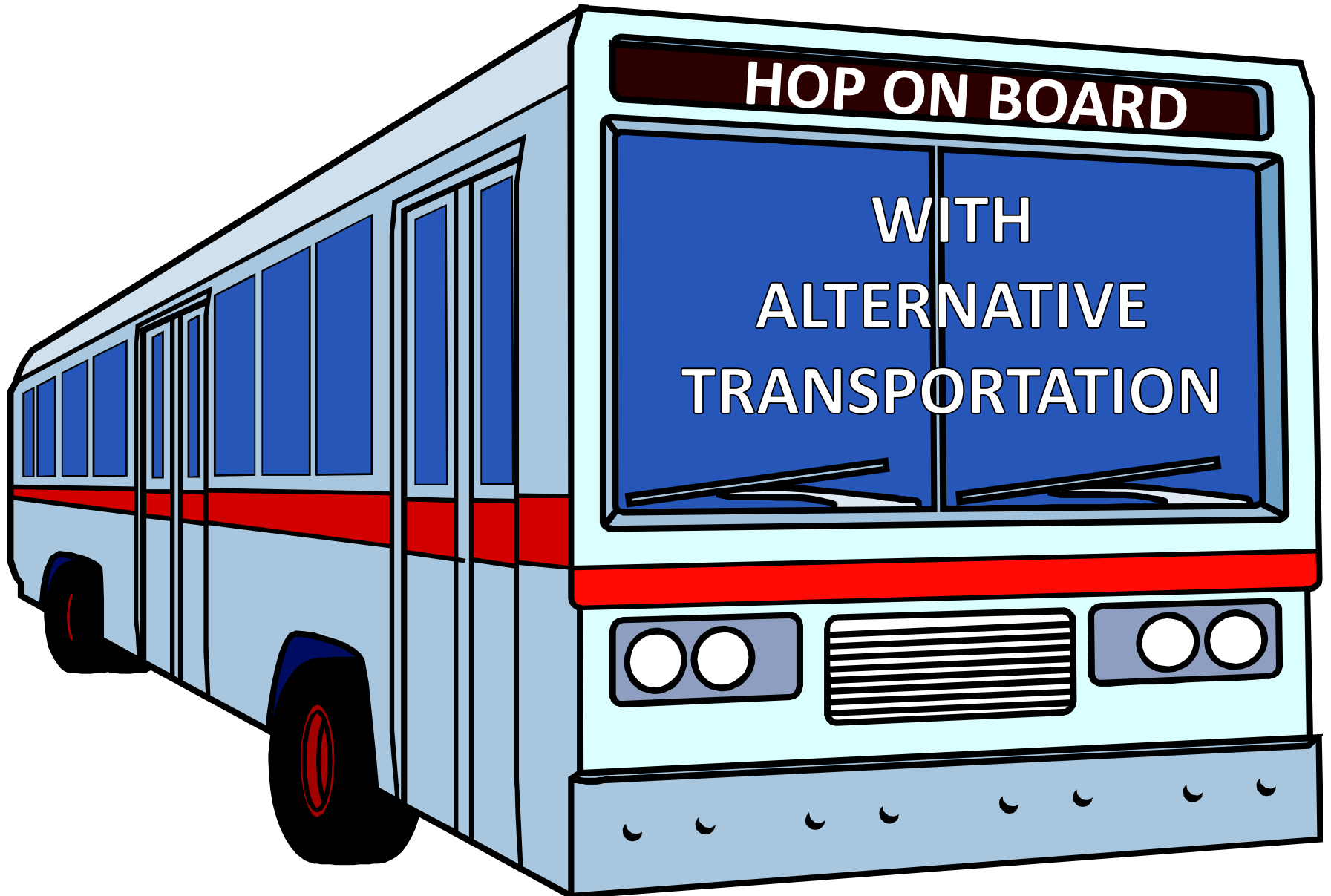


Directions

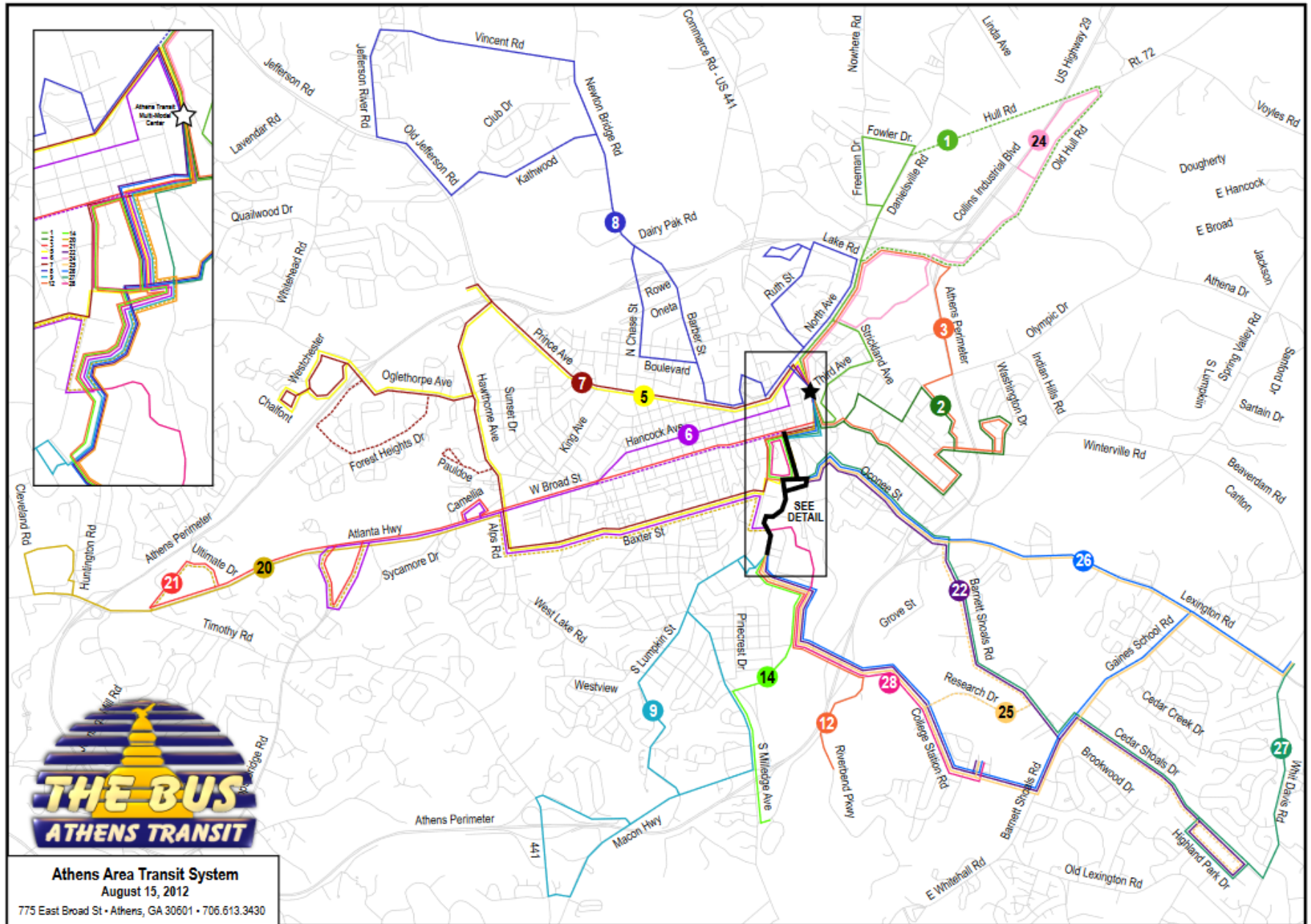
Oh, the places you can go!

One person switching to public transit can reduce daily carbon emissions by **20 pounds**, or more than **4,800 pounds** in a year.
